


**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT ON STUDENT EXCHANGE BETWEEN
COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING, NATIONAL TSING HUA UNIVERSITY
AND
THE GRADUATE SCHOOL OF ENGINEERING, UNIVERSITY OF FUKUI**

The College of Engineering, National Tsing Hua University and the Graduate School of Engineering, University of Fukui, agree to receive students mutually according to the following conditions:

1. Exchange students from both institutions shall be accepted into the receiving institution in the status of "special research student" or "special auditing students with credit".
2. The duration of an individual student's exchange period shall not be less than six months and more than one year, and the time of admission is, in principle, at the beginning of a new semester. Students will be selected by their home university on the basis of academic merit and suitability for study at the host university. Applications will be submitted to the host university beforehand for approval.
3. The number of exchange students shall be three or less per year per institution.
4. The host institution shall charge an overseas student no entrance examination fee, admission fee or tuition.
5. The student's home institution reserves the right to reevaluate his/her scholastic performance to meet the home institution's requirements, if necessary.
6. This memorandum can be amended by mutual consultation and agreement.
7. Issues not covered by this memorandum shall be handled by mutual consultation and agreement.
8. This memorandum shall become valid on the day when both institutions have signed it.

**AGREEMENT ON ACADEMIC EXCHANGE BETWEEN
COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING, NATIONAL TSING HUA UNIVERSITY
AND
THE GRADUATE SCHOOL OF ENGINEERING, UNIVERSITY OF FUKUI**

1. The College of Engineering, National Tsing Hua University and the Graduate School of Engineering, University of Fukui, desiring to develop academic exchange and cooperation in teaching and research for the promotion of the advancement and dissemination of learning, agree on the following matters:
 - (1) Mutual staff visits to participate in the teaching and research programs
 - (2) Mutual enrollment of students as overseas students in the undergraduate and/or post-graduate degree and/or diploma courses provided by the other university.
 - (3) Joint researches in fields of mutual interest
 - (4) Exchange of scientific materials, publications and information
2. Both institutions acknowledge that the visitors shall be subject to compliance with the entry and visa regulations of the respective country and with the university requirements respecting admissions and staff appointment.
3. Both institutions acknowledge that, in the absence of any specific agreement to the contrary, the remuneration, the expenses of traveling and lodging, and other related costs shall be determined at the discretion of, and be the responsibility of the visitor's home institution.
4. Both institutions acknowledge that this agreement will come into effect on the day when it is signed by the representatives of both institutions and it will remain effective for a period of 5 years, and it may be terminated at any time on the basis of the mutual consent of both institutions in nine months after a written notice by either institution.
